What is this type of insurance?

The Hiremaster Hired in Contractors Plant Insurance is a short period policy to cover damage to hired in plant and equipment. It provides cover for costs that you are legally liable to pay as a result of physical loss, destruction or damage to the property insured and the hiring charges levied upon you.



What is insured?

- ✓ Provides cover for self-propelled plant and static plant tools and equipment, which are hired in, under a specified hire agreement up to a maximum of £100,000.
- ✓ Provides short period cover up to a maximum of 30 days.
- Additional payment up to 20% of the sum insured for any hiring charges imposed on the insured following a claim.



Are there any restrictions on cover?

- Excesses which is the part of the claim that you have to pay:
 - i) Self-propelled plant:
 - a) £500 in respect of each and every claim for Accidental Damage.
 - b) £1,000 in respect of each and every claim for Theft or Malicious Damage.
- ii) Non-Self-Propelled Tools and Equipment 10% of the claim value of each and every claim subject to a minimum of £50 and a maximum of £500 increasing to a maximum of £1,000 in respect of Theft and Malicious damage claims



What is not insured?

- ★ Inevitable damage. damage caused by the misuse of a machine or putting it in a situation where damage would be inevitable.
- X Breakdown of the plant.
- X Financial deficiency difference in value of the equipment.
- × Penalties.
- × Products of the business.
- X Corrosion or erosion.
